As 30 year residents of Greenbrae we are writing to express our concern regarding the proposal from Marin Catholic to add nighttime lighting to its athletic field. The proposal is incomplete because it fails to adequately address the impact of the plan on the surrounding neighborhood and on the environment generally.

We do not face Marin Catholic. Nevertheless, we already listen, involuntarily, to the games played there on Saturdays. We can recite the play by play announcing and the crowd reaction. Saturday daytime is not a problem. But nighttime noise of this sort, coupled with intrusive illumination and added traffic will significantly degrade the quality of living that brought us to this neighborhood.

The proposal from Marin Catholic disregards and dismisses these concerns.

Why should someone be allowed to come into our neighborhood, disrupt our lives and then depart to go back to their own homes?

We ask that these issues be given serious consideration in the planning process.
