As a resident of Greenbrae I am writing to express my concern and outrage regarding Marin Catholic's proposal for new lights and to massively increase the utilization of its new facilities at the expense of its neighboring community. I have lived at 100 Vista Grande for over 16 years and have experienced first hand the dramatic increase in noise that has occurred over the years despite Marin Catholic's promises to minimally impact its environment. The noise is extremely loud on my property, and I can hear every word from their PA system, as well as the voices of practicing athletes.

I was very surprised to see that my property has never been included in any of the noise measurements despite being the closest property on Vista Grande to Marin Catholic, and I want to make it clear that I would welcome anyone coming to my property during a Marin Catholic game to get an idea of the level of noise we are subjected to, as numerical measurements of decibels do not permit real life insight into the actual impact.

That Marin Catholic is even proposing to use its lights during evenings throughout the year reveals callous disregard for its neighbors, and it is astounding that a non-public institution would be allowed to inflict such damage to its neighbors and surrounding environment.
